OF EYE CARE SERVICE FOR PEOPLE OF THE MEKONG RIVERSIDE

In Pakbeng District, Oudomxay Province January 07-12, 2024

- Refer to the agreement of the Minister of Foreign Affairs No. 5400/FA. Dated September 21, 2023 regarding approval of the Project Eye Care for People of the Mekong Riverside from the Lao Rehabilitation Foundation (LRF).
- Refer to the action plan of the Project Eye Care for People of the Mekong Riverside in 2024.

The Oudomxay Eye Unit in cooperation with LRF and local staffconducted an eye care mission for people of the Mekong riverside and performed screening vision of students at primary schools at 2 villages, 1 health center and 1 district hospital, the details are as follows:

I. OBJECTIVE:

- To improve the quality and access to eye health services.
- To increase accessibility to service for people in remote areas who have visual impairment and could benefit from prescription glasses.
- To develop a database of visual impairment in children, promote the prevention of eye injury to reduce the risk of blindness or visual impairment in children.

II. LOCATION AND DURATION

Services were provided during 4 days (January 08-11, 2024) at the 2 villages, 1 health center and 1 district hospital as follows:

January 08, 2024 at Saysana Health Center
January 09, 2024 at LuangTong village
January 10, 2024 at Kham village
January 11, 2024 at Pabeng district hospital

4. Instrument and Medicine

This mission was performed using quality modern and basic equipment intended for cataract surgery, refraction exams and effective medicine for treatment. It included:

- Operating Microscope (Scan Optics SO-5000 TFZ)
- 2. Surgical instruments, equipment and supplies
- 3. Sonomed A-Scan

- 4. RightonRetino-MAX K-Plus 3
- 5. Portable slit lamp, direct and indirect ophthalmoscopes
- 6. Tonometer (iCare)
- 7. Mobile autorefractors (Qwicksee, Plenoptika) and trial lens set
- 8. IOL and medical supplies for cataract surgery and medicine for eye care service
- 9. Glasses with eyeglasses case
- 10. Poster for dissemination of knowledge on eye health to prevent eye injury to students

IV. ACTIVITY PERFORMED AND RESULTS

Serviced all people at villages free of charge, with no regard to gender, age, ethnicity or religion. Provided mobile eye care services at 2 villages, 1 health center and 1 district hospital in Pakbeng district:

1. Eye examination, treatment and eye disease control

Provided:

- Vision test by E-Chart or Snellen Chart.
- Diagnosis with medicinal treatment for some eye diseases.
- Cataract surgery with IOL implant.
- Other eye disease surgeries when needed.

A total of 326 (F 155) eye patients were examined, provided vision test with diagnostic examinations and treated at 2 villages, 1 health center and 1 district hospital of Pakbeng district, as follows:

Remark: this mission also performed cataract surgery with IOL implants by modern technique for a little girl with congenital cataract.

2. Refractive error service and donation of glasses

The team of Dr. Luc and Ms. Khammanexamined patients for refractive error by quality modern equipment.

- Refractive error service by portable autorefractor(Qwicksee) and trial lens set
- Donation of glasses.

A total of 311 pairs of glasses were provided, as follows:

3. Control and prevention of blindness in school children

The team conducted screening vision of children at primary school, Dr. Phetsamone disseminated knowledge on eye health and prevention ofeye injury by poster to teachersand students at 1 school.

A total of 127 (F 48) students were screened and eye examined, the results of 100% of students with normal vision was as follows:
