REPORT OF

Cardiology Training for Doctors of Seven District Hospitals of Oudomxay Province

Provided by Lao Rehabilitation Foundation (LRF) in cooperation with DAK Foundation, PEMM Association and Santé France-Laos, Association d'Entraide Médicale



October 3-7, 2016

Beginning in 2008, in cooperation with Oudomxay Hospital, the Lao Rehabilitation Foundation (LRF), funded several health care missions staffed by Lao medical teams assisted by foreign experts for ear, nose & throat (ENT), eye and dental care in the remote areas of four Northern provinces of Laos, including Phongsaly, Luang Namtha, Oudomxay, Bokeo and Xieng Kuang. The outcome of these missions has been highly successful, so far treating over 42,000 patients who otherwise could not have afforded healthcare in the remote areas of these provinces.

LRF has also improved sustainable health care in Laos by building two health care centers and a district hospital in Vientiane and by providing medical equipment and supplies to many health centers, district hospitals in Vientiane Capital, Vientiane province and the Northern provinces.

LRF, DAK Foundation and PEMM Association combined their resources to offer training to doctors from 7 districts hospital of Oudomxay province October 3rd through 7th, 2016. LRF in cooperation with DAK Foundation provided six electrocardiography machines to 6 district hospitals of Oudomxay province, Xay, Namor, La, Nga and Pakbeng districts, while Beng district recieved a similar machine earlier in March 2016. The donation was made in support of the cardiology training program organized by PEMM Association. The donation ceremony took place at Oudomxay provincial hospital with Dr. Phetsamone Indara donating the equipment on behalf of LRF and Dr. Souvanthong Seunvannakham, deputy director of Oudomxay provincial hospital recieving the equipment on behalf of the six districts hospitals. PEMM organized the meeting and provided financial support for the event while Santé France-Laos provided medical expertise.

PURPOSE:

- Advance health care development at district level
- Broaden the coverage of cardiology services for people in distant regions
- Decrease heart diease mortality rate at district level.

PARTICIPANTS:

- 1 teacher (trainer)
- 9 trainees (2 from Oudomxay hospital and 7 from 7 district hospitals)
- 1 observer

TRAINING:

- Set up and maintenance of electrocardiography equipment.
- Interpretation of electrocardiograms
- Understanding cardiac and vascular Doppler ultrasound.
- Awareness of cardiac emergencies:
 - Acute coronary syndrome. Infarction.
 - HTA
 - Heart failure
 - Stroke: ischemic and haemorrhagic
 - Severe arrhythmias.
 - Sudden Death (detection of individuals at risk in Laos)

- Infant heart defects
- Embryology
- Heart murmur in children
- The left-right shunts:
 - Atrial septal defect
 - ventricular septal
 - Persistent ductusarteriosus
- The right-left shunts Cyanogenic heart
- Clinical Case Studies

ACTIVITIES:

Professor Dr. Alphonse PLUQUAILEC (French Cardiologist and founder of Santé France-Laos) provided training as follows:

Day 1: Examination of 3 patients, a 5 year old child, a man aged 44 and a woman of 28 years of age under different conditions: CIV, heart disease and hypertension. Afternoon courses provided on coronary disease after a review of clinical cardiology and acute dyspnea. Teaching by video.

Day 2: Consultation started early with doctors all present, examined 3 patients: a 45 year old man suffering from mitral stenosis, a 2 year old child referred for shorthness of breath by small CIV and a 42 year old woman for hypertension therapeutic noncompliance. After consultation, the interpretation of ECG on hypertension was addressed.

Day 3; 3 patients in consultation (28 year old male for WPW, 45 year old man with cardiothyreosis CMD and 2 year old child probably CIV). The courses were held in optimal conditions in the emergency room with direct projection on large TV screen. The bulk of the heart failure syndrome was discussed after a presentation on acute dyspnea.

Day 4: 5 patients in consultation (7 year old for RAS dyspnea, 14 year old boy for probably an aorto-pulmonary fistula, a man of 50 years for ischemic heart disease, a child of 14 years for a small VSD and a woman of 45 years carrying mitral valve prosthesis for easy control). Afternoon course on interpreting ECGs and stroke.

Day 5: no consultation, courses on rhythm disorders, presentation of certificates of participation and closing of the session.

RESULTS:

This week long training course, improved the knowledge and skills of provincial hospitals Lao doctors in regards to cardiology examination and therapy, especially about the use of electrocardiography in the diagnosis of heart diseases.

FUTURE PLANS:

PEMM Association will return to Oudomxay Hospital in 2017 to follow up with trainees and provide further educational courses in cardiology.
