This healthcare mission was important and necessary for the continued success of preventive eye care to decrease the blindness rate in remote area. This mission was a partnership between the Oudomxay, Phongsaly Provincial Public Health Departments in cooperation with the Lao Rehabilitation Foundation (LRF) and SEE International. It was conducted in 2 districts of Phongsaly Province and at Oudomxay Provincial Hospital, the details are as follows:

I. OBJECTIVE:

- To reduce avoidable blindness in Lao PDR.
- To increase access to high quality eye care services for the people of the two Northern provinces of Phongsaly and Oudomxay.
- To provide sight restoring interventions.

II. TARGET

- Service all eye patients free of charge, with no regard to gender, age, ethnicity or religion.
- Service patients in need of eye care.
- Total estimated target of 100 cataracts surgery in 3 locations.
- Total estimated target of 320 glasses to provide in 2 locations

III. LOCATION AND DURATION

Services were provided during 10 days (May 29-June 09, 2023) in the three locations of:

- May 29-31, 2023

at Mai district hospital

June 1-3, 2023

at Khoua district hospital

- June 5-9, 2023

at Oudomxay provincial hospital

IV. SUPPORT, TEAMWORK, PARTNERS and INSTRUMENTS

1. Support

By Lao Rehabilitation Foundation (LRF) in cooperation with SEE International.

LAO REHABILITATION FOUNDATION (LRF):

The Lao Rehabilitation Foundation, Inc. (LRF) headquartered in Napa, California, USA, is a non-profit, non-religious, non-political organization. Activities are conducted by its President, Dr. Luc Janssens. The purpose of LRF is to provide medical services to Laotian citizens, with a greater focus on children. The foundation recognizes that the best guarantee for sound health is adequate nutrition, access to clean water, basic hygiene, decent shelter, education and reasonable access to medical facilities. The Foundation has conducted multiple missions in the remote areas of Laos providing medical services and clean water to the poor. The Foundation has also provided medical equipment to provincial hospitals, district hospitals and health centers in Vientiane capital and many provinces of Northern Laos.

4. Instrument and Medicine

This mission was performed using quality modern and basic equipment intended for cataract surgery, refraction exams and effective medicine for treatment. It included:

- 1. Operating Microscope (Scan Optics SO-5000 TFZ)
- 2. Surgical instruments, equipment and supplies
- 3. 2 portable autoclaves
- 4. Sonomed A-Scan
- 5. Righton Retino-MAX K-Plus 3
- 6. Portable slit lamp, direct and indirect ophthalmoscopes
- 7. Tonometer (iCare)
- 8. Mobile autorefractors (Qwicksee)
- 9. Trial lens set
- 10.IOL and medical supplies for cataract surgery
- 11. Medicine for eye care service
- 12. Glasses and eyeglasses case

V. RESPONSIBLE UNITS

1. Phongsaly Provincial Public Health Department

- Provided official agreement.
- Provided location and appointment information to patients in remote areas.
- Cooperated with and organized the local staff to join the mobile team.

2. Oudomxay Provincial Public Health Department

Provided the Lao team from Oudomxay provincial hospital.

3. Lao Rehabilitation Foundation

- Provided medical instruments and medicine for the mission.
- Provided transportation and accommodations for the Lao and US teams and per diem for Lao team
- Covered cost of treatment and hospital stay in some cases, as necessary.

VI. ACTIVITY PERFORMED

Provided mobile eye care services in 2 districts hospitals (Mai, Bountai districts of Phongsaly province) and at Oudomxay provincial hospital. Registration of cases was completed by local staff. Eye examination and diagnosis was performed with manual or automated equipment. Patients were treated with medicine, restored sight by glasses and surgical procedures, as follows:

- Vision test by E-Chart or Snellen Chart.
- Diagnosis with medicinal treatment for some eye diseases.
- Refractive service with donation of glasses.
- Cataract surgery with IOL implant.
- Other eye disease surgery when needed.
- Health education of primary eye care and post-operative procedures.
- Referred cases to Oudomxay provincial hospital for treatment supported by LRF.

VII. RESULTS

A total of 662 (F 338) eye patients were examined, provided vision test with diagnostic examinations and treated in the three locations of Mai, Khoua districts and Oudomxay provincial hospitals. Surgery was provided for 125 patients and 328 pairs of glasses were distributed for refractive error patients, as follows:

IX. ACCOMPLISHMENTS AND WEAKNESSES

Accomplishments:

- We treated impoverished patients who otherwise would not have received help.
- We helped prevent blindness in Phongsaly and Oudomxay provinces.
- This mission was particularly successful for giving sight to 2 young brothers who now enjoy a normal life after surgery for bilateral congenital cataract.

2. Weaknesses:

- The team was limited to only one ophthalmologist who could do phaco surgery.
- This mission could not screen primary school students for vision, because the school was closed for vacation at the end of May.

- 1. Provide refraction and provide glasses at the villages. *
- 2. Screen primary schools children for eye care.
